CARE INSTRUCTIONS



1. STORAGE:

Store doors in a flat position in a dry area at all times. Avoid exposure to excessive moisture or extreme temperature fluctuations.



2. MEASUREMENT AND SIZING:

Before purchasing a door, accurately measure the height and width of the opening where you intend to install it. Ensure the measurements are precise to select the appropriate door size for a proper fit.



3. UNPACKING AND TRIMMING:

Remove any packaging or protective coverings from the door.

Contact ABS Doors & Timber for trimming allowance guidelines to fit the door to the opening, if necessary.



4. EXTERIOR DOORS:

For exterior doors, it is important to note that they require exterior-grade finishes to protect them from the elements.

Applying suitable finishes, such as weather-resistant paints or sealants, is essential to prevent damage and maintain the warranty.



5. INSTALLATION:

Install entrance doors in weather-protected situations whenever possible to minimize exposure to harsh weather conditions.

Use at least three hinges when fitting solid doors. Larger doors may require four hinges or a pivot hinge system to adequately support the weight.



6. HINGE PLACEMENT AND SIZE:

Follow the manufacturer's guidelines regarding hinge placement and size for proper installation.

Adhering to these recommendations ensures the door's optimal operation and helps prevent sagging over time.

Remember to consult the specific care and maintenance instructions provided by ABS Doors & Timber the manufacturer for any additional guidance. We are here to assist you.

GUARANTEE

We ABS Doors & Timber, hereby provide the following guarantee (hereinafter referred to as the "Guarantee") for the doors supplied by our company:



COVERAGE:

1.1 This Guarantee covers the doors supplied by ABS Doors & Timber, and it applies to defects in material and workmanship found in the doors during normal use and service.

1.2 The Guarantee is valid for a period of 5 years from the date of purchase.



GUARANTEE BENEFITS:

2.1 In the event that a defect covered by this Guarantee is identified within the guarantee period, we will, at our sole discretion:

- a) Repair the defective door component(s) or
- b) Replace the defective door component(s) with an equivalent or similar product.



GUARANTEE EXCLUSIONS:

- 3.1 This Guarantee does not cover damage or defects resulting from:
- a) Improper installation, handling, or use of the doors.
- b) Lack of proper maintenance or failure to follow the care and maintenance instructions provided by ABS Doors & Timber.
- c) Misuse, abuse, or intentional damage caused by the client or any third party.
- d) Alterations, modifications, or repairs made by unauthorized personnel.
- e) Acts of nature, fire, flood, earthquake, or other external events beyond the control of ABS Doors & Timber.



CLIENT'S OBLIGATIONS:

- 4.1 To avail themselves of the benefits of this Guarantee, the client must:
- a) Notify ABS Doors & Timber in writing promptly upon discovering the defect covered by this Guarantee. b) Provide proof of purchase or installation, along with a detailed description and supporting evidence of the claimed defect.
- c) Cooperate with ABS Doors & Timber in the inspection and evaluation of the claimed defect, if required



LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY:

5.1 To the fullest extent permitted by law, ABS Doors & Timber's liability under this Guarantee is limited to the repair or replacement of defective door components as stated in Section 2.

5.2 ABS Doors & Timber shall not be liable for any indirect, incidental, consequential, or special damages arising from the use or inability to use the doors covered by this Guarantee.

5.3 This Guarantee does not affect the client's statutory rights under applicable consumer protection laws.



TRANSFERABILITY:

6.1 This Guarantee is transferable to subsequent owners of the doors during the guarantee period, provided that the new owner notifies ABS Doors & Timber in writing of the transfer.



DISPUTE RESOLUTION:

7.1 Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this Guarantee shall be resolved through good faith negotiations between the parties.

7.2 If a resolution cannot be reached, the parties agree to submit the dispute to mediation or arbitration.

WARRANTY



WARRANTY COVERAGE:

1.1 ABS Doors & Timber warrants that the doors supplied to the Client shall be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use and service.

1.2 The warranty covers the repair or replacement, at the sole discretion of ABS Doors & Timber, of any defective door components, including but not limited to frames, panels, hardware, and finishes, subject to the terms and conditions stated herein.



DIIDATION

2.1 This warranty is valid for a period of 5 years from the date of purchase, with proof of receipt.
2.2 The warranty is non-transferable and applies solely to the original Client who purchased or received the doors directly from ABS Doors & Timber.



WARRANTY EXCLUSIONS:

- 3.1 This warranty does not cover damage or defects resulting from:
- a) Improper installation, handling, or use of the doors.
- b) Lack of proper maintenance or failure to follow the care and maintenance instructions provided by ABS Doors & Timber.
- c) Misuse, abuse, or intentional damage caused by the Client or any third party.
- d) Alterations, modifications, or repairs made by unauthorized personnel.
- e) Acts of nature, fire, flood, earthquake, or other external events beyond ABS Doors & Timber control.



CLAIMS PROCESS:

4.1 In the event of a defect covered by this warranty, the Client must promptly notify ABS Doors & Timber in writing within 30 days of purchase.

4.2 The Client must provide proof of purchase or installation, along with a detailed description and supporting evidence of the claimed defect.

4.3 ABS Doors & Timber reserves the right to inspect and evaluate the claimed defect before authorizing any repairs or replacements under this warranty.



ABS DOORS & TIMBER OBLIGATIONS:

5.1 If a valid claim is made within the warranty period and is accepted by ABS Doors & Timber, it will, at its sole discretion:

- a) Repair the defective door component(s) or
- b) Replace the defective door component(s) with an equivalent or similar product.
- 5.2 ABS Doors & Timber may choose to use new or refurbished parts or components for repairs or replacements.



LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY:

6.1 To the fullest extent permitted by law, ABS Doors & Timber's liability under this warranty is limited to the repair or replacement of defective door components as stated in Section 5.
6.2 ABS Doors & Timber shall not be liable for any indirect, incidental, consequential, or special damages arising from the use or inability to use the doors covered by this warranty.
6.3 This warranty does not affect the Client's statutory rights under applicable consumer protection laws.



DISPUTE RESOLUTION:

7.1 Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this warranty shall be resolved through good faith negotiations between the Parties.

7.2 If a resolution cannot be reached, the Parties agree to submit the dispute to mediation or arbitration.
